WHAT IS THE OEM ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY TRAINEESHIP?

The Original Equipment Manufacturing (OEM) Engineering Technology Traineeship prepares trainees for work as future engineers/technicians and combines theory and practical industry experience to provide a basic understanding of manufacturing and engineering processes.

DURATION

This is a full time course, starting in September with 12 weeks work based learning in Combilift and 26 weeks classroom based learning in Monaghan Institute.

COURSE CONTENT

Upon successful completion, students will be awarded a Level 5 QQI in Engineering Technology and City & Guilds Level 2 in Hydraulics. In addition individuals will complete Lean Manufacturing workshops.

Course modules include:

- Auto Electricity
- Engineering Processes
- CAD (2D)

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be 16+;
- Have achieved Leaving Cert or equivalent or a QQI Level 4 or relevant work experience;
- Or achieved GCSEs, NVQ Level 2, BTEC or equivalent qualifications or relevant work experience.
- Applications are also welcome from those in employment who are seeking to upskill or reskill into this industry.

- On successful completion of the Traineeship and QQI Award, trainees may decide to apply for the OEM Apprenticeship or further study at the next or higher level of the National Framework of Qualification, including qualifications in Institutes of Technology or Universities.
